


Graham Norton's debut novel, *Holding*, is a gripping and emotionally resonant story about family, love, and loss.



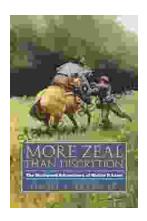
