

3NT (Over 1NT): A balanced hand with 12-14 points.

4NT (Over 1NT): A balanced hand with 15-17 points.

Cue Bids

1 of a suit (After an Intermediate Bid): A cue bid that shows a maximum of two small cards in the suit.

2 of a suit (After an Intermediate Bid): A cue bid that shows a maximum of one small card in the suit.




