David Crosby, founding member of the Byrds and Crosby, Stills & Nash, passed away at the age of 81.

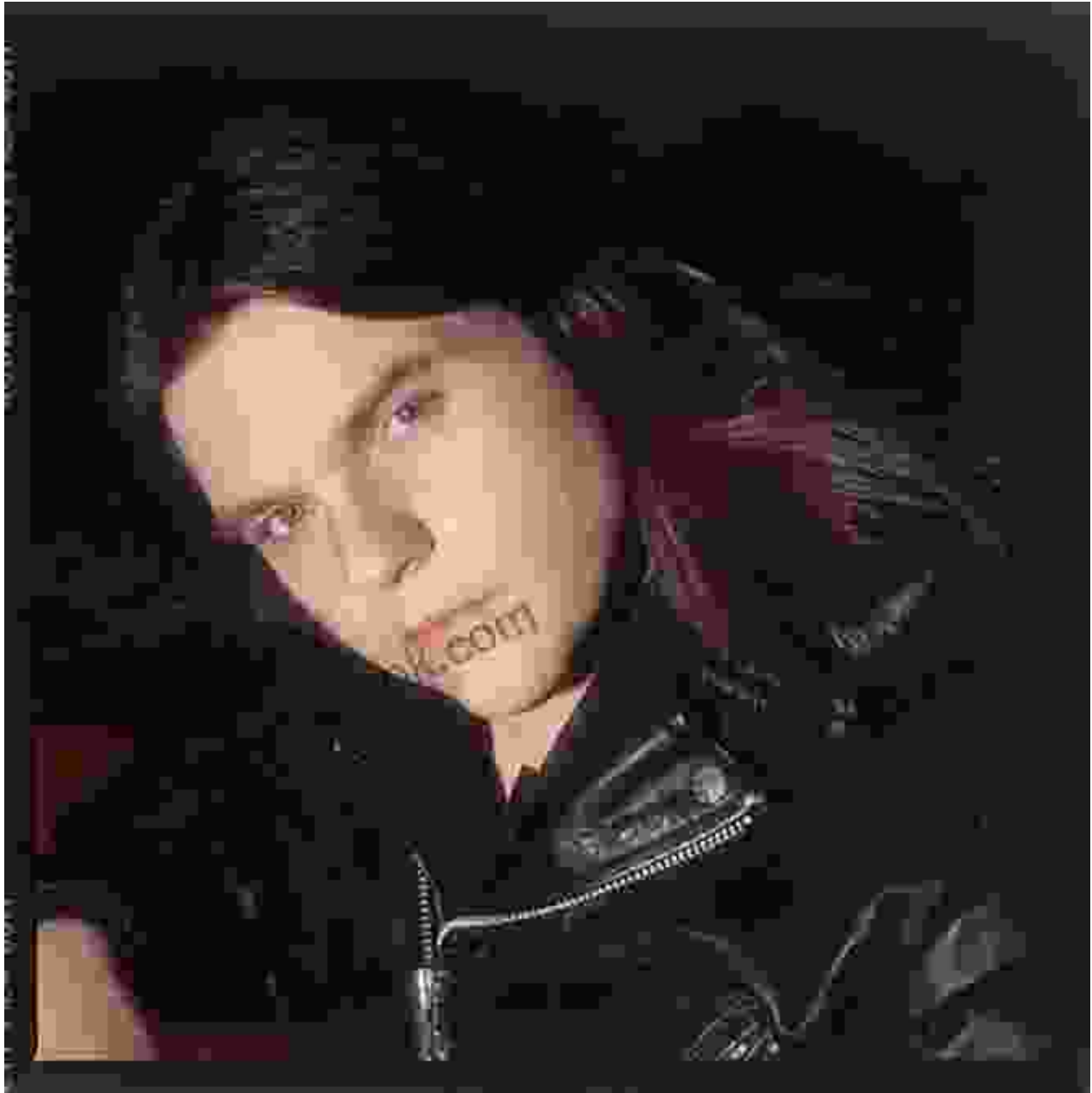
