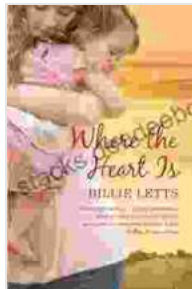


# Where the Heart Is: A Tale of Love, Loss, and Redemption

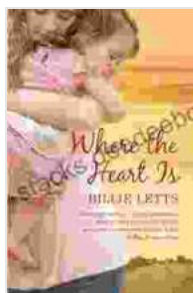
